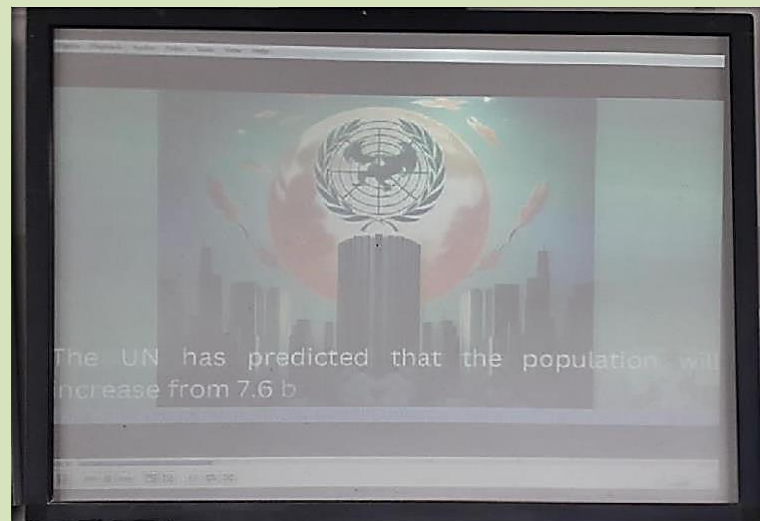
Objectives: To improve pronunciation, vocabulary and fluency to create awareness amongst students about the growing population.
