Induction programme for New Pre-primary parents

The objective of an induction program for pre-primary education includes the following goals:

1. ****Orientation****: Introduce children to the new school environment, including classrooms, playgrounds, and other facilities.
2. ****Socialization****: Help children develop social skills by interacting with peers and teachers, promoting a sense of belonging and community.
3. ****Routine Establishment****: Familiarize children with the daily schedule and routines of the school to provide a sense of structure and predictability.
4. ****Skill Development****: Begin the development of basic academic skills such as recognizing letters, numbers, shapes, and colors.
5. ****Emotional Support****: Provide emotional support to children to ease the transition from home to school, addressing separation anxiety and building trust with teachers.
6. ****Parental Involvement****: Engage parents in the educational process, informing them about the curriculum, school policies, and ways to support their child's learning at home.
7. ****Safety and Well-being****: Ensure children understand and follow basic safety rules and feel secure in the new environment.
8. ****Exploration and Play****: Encourage exploration and play-based learning to stimulate curiosity and cognitive development.
