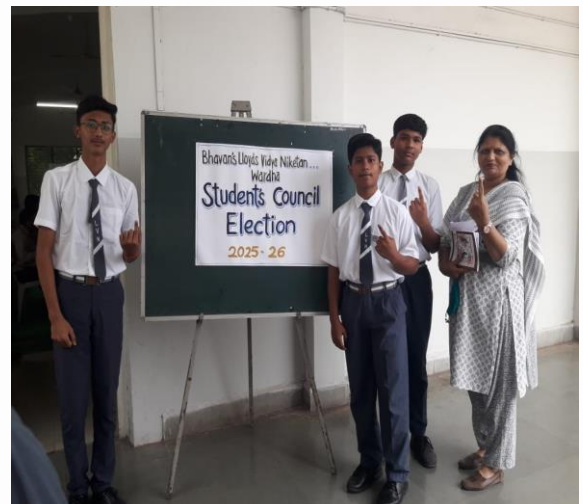
ELECTION FOR SCHOOL'S MINISTRY- STUDENTS' COUNCIL
