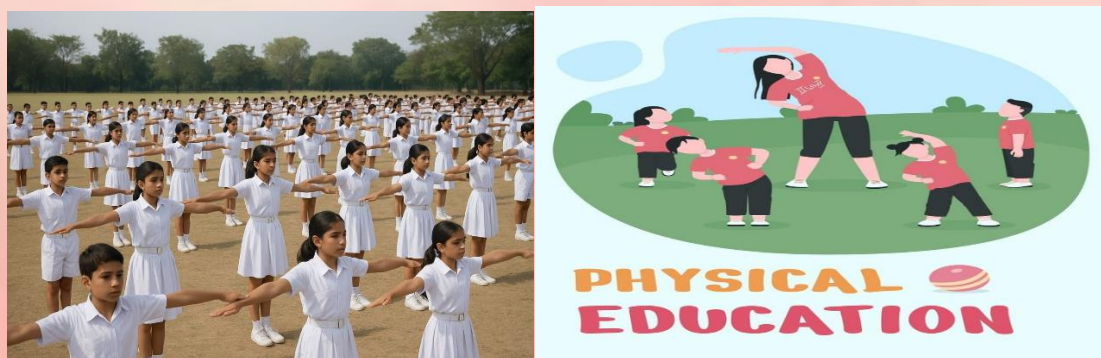
The morning assembly was conducted in a disciplined and organized manner.
